The Grande Prairie Skating Club is offering a competition simulation day on Saturday November 26, 2011 running from 9:00am – 12:30pm. This is open to all skaters with music Freeskate programs and short programs for Arctic Winter Games run offs. Coaches will get you this information only if your skater qualifies to participate. The cost is \$15 per program. Coaches will charge gate fees for each skate as they do in a typical competition.

A simulation is designed to have skaters skate their programs as if they were in competition. Skaters will be required to dress as if it were a competition with hair and make-up done accordingly. Simulations can help skaters with nerves or just get a program out there for the first time on the ice alone.

For this particular simulation we will have a judge overseeing the run through performances and providing the coaches with feedback to help skaters prepare for their next event.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be a schedule done once all forms are turned in with payment. The judge will dictate what order things are going to be done in and skaters will have to plan to skate between 9:00am – 12:30pm. We will not be able to move skates around to accommodate other activities so please save that time frame on your calendar if you are signing up.

***Forms must be completed in full and turned in to the office NO LATER than Sunday November 20, 2011. This is so we can get a schedule done and approved Monday to give people as much notice as possible.**

We will be hosting an in house competition in February that will incorporate skaters with elements programs and Primary skaters.
